Dear teachers:

With the arrival of the new school year 2021-2022, we present you the didactic programme of the Provincial Museum of Firefighters of Alcoy (MuBoma). From the Didactics Department we would like to make every visit to the museum a unique experience, always enriching and entertaining.

For the second consecutive year, the health situation derived from the COVID-19 marks the current situation, so both our facilities and services have been adapted to be able to offer you the maximum safety guarantees. The proposal that we present to you below is designed taking into account the use of outdoor space as much as possible.

MuBoma is a different kind of museum: the building itself takes us back to the city's industrial past in the 19th century; the permanent exhibition, which aims to be a reflection on the link between people and fire since prehistoric times and how the firefighting profession has evolved throughout history.

MuBoma's educational activities have been limited to very specific actions that are adapted to all educational levels. The aim is to be an additional support for educational centres, delving into concepts linked to fire, water and industrialisation, together with cultural and environmental heritage, trying to develop skills such as creativity and teamwork.

We hope that this information may be of interest to you and that you will visit us soon.

LOCATION

MuBoma is located at 64 Alcazares Street; it can be reached by bus, with parking space available.

It is a fully accessible space, with a lift inside for people with reduced mobility. There are seating areas in the audiovisual areas for resting during the tour.

It is also interesting to know that in the vicinity there is a green area on the banks of the River Riquer, fitted out as a riverside promenade with a children's playground.



WORKSHOPS AND GAMES

While the **PANDEMIC** situation lasts, a contingency plan has been drawn up to guarantee the safety of visitors. The educational workshops are subject to the following rules:

- **Small groups:** the capacity is determined by the health authorities at any given time and/or spaces used. It may vary throughout the evolution of the pandemic.
- **Mandatory use of masks** (from 6 years of age). Even outdoors as these are not static activities.
- **All visitors will have their temperature taken on arrival.**
- **The didactic activities will take place outdoors** (the organisation may make the necessary changes in case the weather does not allow it).
- **The use of hydroalcoholic gel is compulsory** at the beginning of the visit and before each educational activity.

INFANT - 1ST PRIMARY

A story in pieces - After the visit, the group will be brought together to tell them a story, at the end of which they will have to make up the figure of a fireman by putting together all the pieces and parts of the uniform and materials.



2ND TO 4TH PRIMARY

Let's go to the factory! - After the visit, there will be a recreation game to find out what it was like to work in a textile factory. From importing raw materials with the Alcoy-Gandia train to exporting them.



5TH AND 6TH PRIMARY / SECONDARY

- **Kim's game** - After the visit there will be a team game to recognise and remember the name and usefulness of various pieces exhibited in the MuBoma.



GROUPS WITH FUNCTIONAL DIVERSITY

- **Guess, guess** - Using their sense of touch, they will discover some of the materials in the museum (gloves must be worn, unless justified exceptions).

PRICE

1,50 € per student (guided tour + educational workshop).

Free for teachers and people with functional diversity (Guess the riddle workshop).

Payment must be made in cash or by credit card on the day of the visit.

Payment by bank transfer must be made a few days before the visit and proof of payment must be sent 24 hours before the group's arrival.

Visits usually last 1 hour and workshops last approximately 20 minutes.

For health and hygiene reasons it is not possible to stay for lunch on the museum grounds. Only breakfast in the morning.
